



School Uniform Policy- Secondary

Secondary School: Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11

- Plain Cream hijab (head scarf)
- Plain, loose and long brown jilbab/abaya
- Cream Cardigan - no other colour
- Plain brown or black trousers, no jeans
- Plain Black shoes/ trainers
- Black Socks

The following are NOT allowed:

- Sequins, brocade etc.
- Fancy broaches, bows or headbands
- High buns
- Big artificial buns, with extra hair bands or scarves around them in order to add volume to the hijab. Pupils with big buns may be asked remove their hijabs in order to enforce this.
- Jewellery, except for studs and a watch. Any jewellery maybe be confiscated and parents will be asked to pick it up within 6 months or they will be disposed of.
- Make-up or nail varnish
- Coloured contact lenses
- Nose studs
- Hoodies
- Black abaya/jilbab or head scarf

All children must look presentable when attending school. All pupils will wear the uniform correctly or risk a series of consequences. We do reserve the right to send children home if they are not dressed appropriately. We expect parents to encourage their children to wear correct uniform and support the school rules.
